Energy – Fixed tariff when time-of-use incremental meter data is unavailable	-	\$0.72/kWh	Council has identified a number of electricity smart meters with configuration or connectivity issues. In some cases historical time-of-use incremental data is unavailable for retrospective unbilled periods. This presents a challenge in billing these meters under the dynamic tariff scheme, since time-of-use half hour data is required for accurate billing. This fee will be charged in these instances and is based on the weighted average of dynamic tariffs based on the hourly load from October 2023-June 2024.
Quarry			
Sale of hardfill from site 44a	-	\$40.00/tonne	Over the last few years Council has been progressively screening overburden material at the site known as 44A (Portion 44A) on Cascade Road next to the school. As this material is surplus to Council requirements it can be offered for sale to the community. It is recommended that the quarry overburden material be sold at \$40 per tonne to recoup some of the screening costs associated with the quarry operation. The fill has been priced to reflect the material quality.
