I need to highlight to you all that the agreed procedure is being followed closely, and that following the closure of this survey on Friday 24 September, [REDACTED]

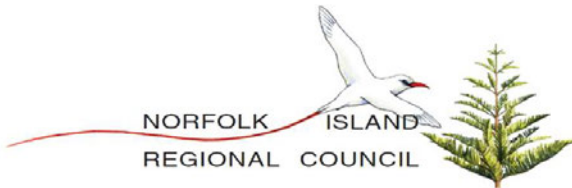
The Transition to Sustainability is a difficult road for this organisation, but one that we must achieve before Christmas.
