Norfolk Island Regional Council's Waste Management Centre Team has continued its efforts to improve the presentation of the facility, recently planting more than 40 new plants in the garden bed near the site's front gate.

In addition to planting new greenery, staff have been working on a range of improvements across the site, including better signage and general site improvement works.
