PASTURAGE AND ENCLOSURE ACT 1949 (NI) APPLICATION FOR PASTURAGE RIGHTS FOR THE TWELVE MONTHS COMMENCING 1 APRIL 2026

Pasturage Rights Applications

In accordance with sub-section 5(a) and (b) of the *Pasturage and Enclosure Act 1949* (NI) a cattle owner may on the form provided, and during the last 14 days of December in any year apply to the Acting General Manager/Conservator for a right of pasturage for the year commencing on the next succeeding 1 April.

<u>development/documents/cattle</u> <u>application for rights of pasturage.pdf</u>) or from Customer Care, Council Bicentennial Complex, 39 Taylors Road, Burnt Pine, Norfolk Island.

Application forms can be lodged in person to Customer care or via email customercare@nirc.gov.nf.

To be eligible to be granted pasturage rights, an applicant must be an individual who:

- is at least 18 years of age; and
- must be an owner of stock.

There are a limited number of pasturage rights available, and there will be no increase in the current number of tags in 2026-2027. The Norfolk Island Regional Council allocates pasturage rights according to its policies and procedures which are applicable at the time.

Fees

The fee payable for each head of cattle over the age of 6 months is \$185 and is payable after an applicant is advised if they have been successful in securing pasturage right(s).
