TRAFFIC ACT 2010 (NI) TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROAD

I, Scott Hackney, Acting General Manager and Acting Chief Executive Officer of the Norfolk Island Regional Council, under section 50 of the *Traffic Act 2010* (NI), close that part, or parts, of the road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to all vehicular traffic (except any vehicle specified in Part 2 of the Schedule) for, and during, the hours of **7:00am – 3:00pm** as is necessary to ensure public safety during the **road repairs**.
