## LIQUOR ACT 2025 (NI) LIQUOR LICENSING RENEWALS

Liquor licensees are reminded that liquor licences issued under the *Liquor Act 2005* (NI) expire on **30 June 2026**.

Applications for the **renewal, transfer, variation, relocation, or grant** of a licence must be lodged with Customer Care at the Bicentennial Complex, Taylors Road, **on or before 10 June 2026**, together with the relevant fee:

### Fees

- Application for Grant of Licence — \$735.00
- Application for Renewal of Licence — \$735.00
- Application to Transfer, Vary or Relocate a Licence — \$110.00
- Application for Appointment of Nominee — \$110.00

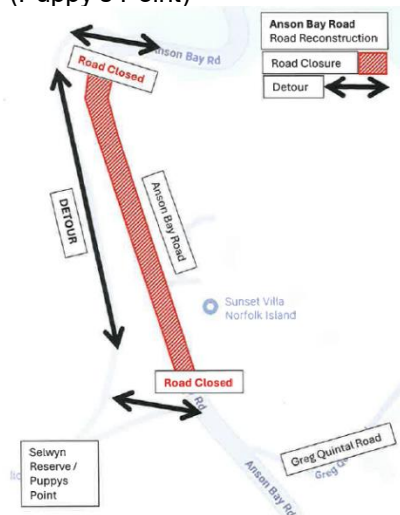
## TRAFFIC ACT 2010 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROAD

I, Scott Hackney, Acting General Manager and Chief Executive Officer of the Norfolk Island Regional Council, under section 50 of the Traffic Act 2010, close that part, or parts, of the road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to all vehicular traffic (except any vehicle specified in Part 2 of the Schedule) for, and during, the hours of **7:00am – 5:00pm** as is necessary to ensure public safety during the **road reconstruction repairs**.

### SCHEDULE

#### Part 1 – Road Closure Details:

- **Date:** up to eight (8) days between 18 May – 30 June 2026
- **Time:** 7:00am – 5:00pm
- **Location:** Anson Bay Road – Between Greg Quintal Road and Selwyn Reserve (Puppy's Point - northern end)
