We have unfortunately had a few instances of unsanitary damage to public toilets recently.

We encourage everyone to keep up the great work with a few helpful reminders:

- Treating public toilets and facilities with care
- Keeping picnic and BBQ areas tidy after use
- Avoiding placing private household waste in public bins, as this can quickly lead to overflow.

When public bins fill up with private household waste, they cannot be used by people enjoying the areas for picnics or BBQs.

Similarly, damage and vandalism to facilities takes more time and resources away from maintaining the public spaces for the community.

Council appreciates the many residents and visitors who consistently do the right thing. With everyone continuing to play their part, our public facilities and spaces will remain welcoming places for all to use.
